REMANUFACTURING THE SHARP AM-300/400/900 TONER CARTRIDGE

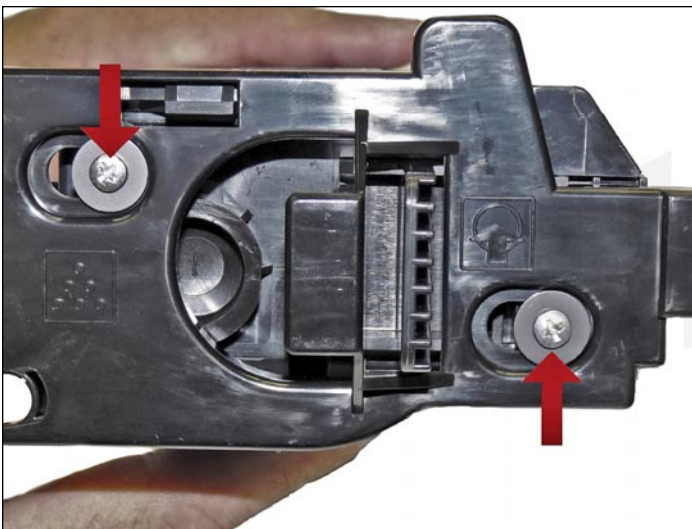

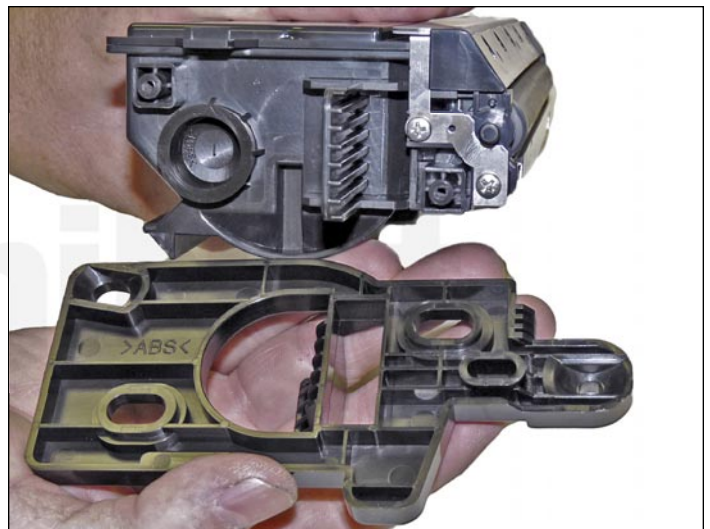
The Sharp AM-900 toner cartridges are rated for 3,000 pages. The part numbers for the cartridge is AM-90D or AM-30DC outside the US.

There is NO chip used on this cartridge.

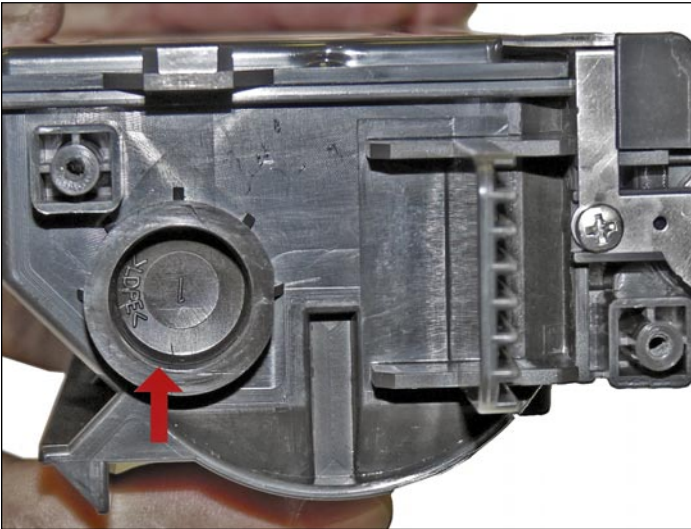
NOTE: The developer roller on this cartridge can be removed for a full cleaning but as the doctor blade is very easily damaged, its better left alone.



1. Remove the two screws from the end cap.



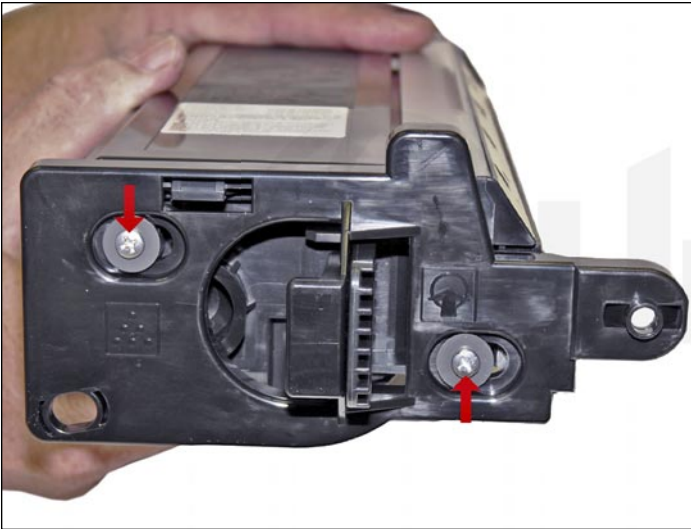
2. Remove the end cap.



3. Remove the fill plug and clean out all the remaining toner from the hopper.



4. Fill the hopper with toner for use in the Sharp AM-90D (AM-30DC) cartridge, and replace the fill plug.



5. Slide the end cap so it fits over the top tab.

Install the two screws.
